
Respected sir,

VJNT, SBC & OBC Welfare Department has received above mentioned reference no.1 letter dated 21 June, 2019 from Higher and Technical Education Department. Vide this letter H & T E.Dept has brought to the notice of this department that admission process for engineering and other professional courses under technical education directorate has been started for the Educational Year 2019-20.

2. In view of above mentioned facts on issue of caste validity certificate of newly created socially and economically backward class students (SEBC), a meeting under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Maharashtra was held on 26.06.2019 at 10.30 a.m. in Vidhanbhavan. After through discussion at length on this issue, it was unanimously decided that as SEBC category is not a part of The Maharashtra Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, De-Notified Tribes (Vimukta Jatis), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Special Backward Category (Regulation of Issuance And Verification of) Caste Certificate Act, 2000, Hence caste validity certificate for SEBC category students should not be insisted till further instructions/ order.

3. In view of above mentioned facts. I am directed to mention on behalf of VJNT, SBC & OBC Welfare Department that caste validity certificate for SEBC category students should not be insisted till further instructions/ order. In the light of these instructions admission controlling authority of Maharashtra State is requested to proceed further admission process of SEBC category students.
