REVISED ADMISSION NOTICE FOR MBA/MMS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

In pursuant to the WP (ST) No 20304 of 2019, Hon. High Court of Bombay, the allotment of CAP Round I published on 17th July 2019 shall be reprocessed by considering status of JBIMS as Autonomous Institution. In view of this, all Maharashtra & All India Candidates who have been allotted seat in CAP Round I and such candidates who have reported to the allotted institute for admission stands cancelled. The revised Seat Matrix for JBIMS as Autonomous Institution is published on website.

All Maharashtra & All India candidates are hereby informed to fill and confirm fresh options or edit already filled options through their login for CAP Round I.
