The online Common Entrance Test for post graduate of Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech & Language Pathology/Audiology and Prosthetics & Orthotics Courses PGP-CET/PGO-CET/M.Sc.(SLP)/M.Sc.(Audio)-CET and M.Sc. (P&O) CET - 2020 was conducted on Wednesday, 02nd December, 2020 by Competent Authority appointed by Government of Maharashtra. The Question papers all Four (04) Examination were displayed on 02/12/2020 and the provisional keys of the same were displayed on 03/12/2020. After the declaration of provisional key, this office has received 33 representations in PGP CET 2020 & 02 representations in PGO CET 2020 and 13 representations for M.Sc.(SLP)/M.Sc.(Audio) CET 2020 related to questions and key options. The Commissioner, State CET Cell had requested to Registrar, MUHS to appoint subject experts to verify the objections. The final result/Merit list is being declared on 11/12/2020.

With respect to PGP CET - 2020 the subject experts have opined that Four (04) questions in PGP CET 2020 are non-evaluative/invalid. The Competent Authority on the basis of the opinion of the respective subject expert has taken a decision to make these Four (04) questions from PGP CET 2020 "non-evaluative/Invalid". The Competent Authority has decided to allot one mark for this non-evaluative Four (04) MCQ to all candidates who appeared PGP CET 2020 examination to the respective subject. The detail of One invalid question of PGP CET 2020 is shown in **Table No.1**.

The subject experts also opined that there is change in answer key options in Two (02) questions from PGP CET 2020. It differs from the Provisional Answer key published on website. These Two (02) questions from PGP CET 2020 are correct and hence are
