The vacant All India Quota Postgraduate Medical seats in Government/Corporation/Central Government/Government Aided Institutes has been surrendered to the State quota on **01<sup>st</sup> July, 2020**. The seat matrix of available seat has been published on 06/07/2020.

This office has completed the first round of counseling process. At the end of first Round there are few Vacant seats. The schedule to fill vacant seats of Government/Corporation/ Central Government/Private Unaided/Minority Dental Colleges (50% State Quota, 35 % Institutional Quota and 15% NRI Quota) through Second Round and MOP UP round(s) counseling will be as stated bellow:

**Instruction to Candidates :-**

1. The allotment letter will be considered as E-Pass/Curfew pass to facilitate candidates along with one parent / Attendant during travel for the purpose of reporting to allotted college.
2. Selected candidate should report physically to join allotted college with all original document and requisite fees to secure admission.
3. In case of upgradation / betterment of candidate who joined during previous round, the original document and fees paid during admission should be refunded by college authority immediately to account of the concerned candidate.
4. Any candidate who has joined up to 17/07/2020, if desires to cancel /resigns their seat at Government/Corporation/Central Government institutions, **after 5.00 PM on 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2020** will have to pay a penalty of Rs.10 Lakhs for Non completion of Junior Residency/ Course as per rule No. 21.1 in addition to Rs. 10 Lakhs for lapse of seat as per rule No. 21.2 of Information Brochure of NEET MDS 2020. If such a candidate resigns **after 5.00 PM on 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2020**, even after paying Rs.20 Lakhs, he/she will not be eligible for admission through state Quota for subsequent two Academic Years.
5. Any candidates who joins during MOP UP Round I, if desires to cancel/ resign a seat **after 05.00 PM on 22/07/2020**, such a candidate is liable for penalty of Rs.20 Lakhs as per rule No. 21.1 & 21.2 of Information Brochure of NEET MDS 2020. He/She will not be eligible for admission through state Quota for subsequent two Academic Years.
6. Any candidate selected in MOP UP round (s), fails to join or resign **after** joining to an allotted seat, then such a candidate will have to pay penalty as per rule No. 21.1 & 21.2, as well as he/she will not be eligible for admission through state Quota for subsequent two Academic Years.
7. Vacant seats of Private Unaided and Minority Medical Colleges **after 5.00 PM on 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2020** will be filled by the Institution as per schedule mentioned in table no IV. For this CET Cell will publish the list of eligible waitlisted candidates on the website.

8. Any candidate who resigns their seat from Unaided Private/ Minority Medical college **after 5.00 PM of 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2020**, will have to pay three years' fees as a penalty as per Rule No. 21.6 of NEET MDS 2020 Information Brochure.
9. Candidate selected for Second round, MOP UP- I, MOP UP- II round and Institution level round will have to join physically and deposit all original document and requisite full fees.
- 10. Candidates who have joined online in round – I and not upgraded during round II, will have to confirm the seat of round- I by paying full fees (if not paid already) and have to join/report physically up to 17/07/2020, failing which his / her admission will be treated cancelled.**
11. The online joining is not permitted during second round, MOP UP – I, MOP UP – II and Institutional level round. Candidate will have join/report physically during aforesaid rounds.

**Procedure for Institutional Round for NEET-PG-2020 courses -**

1. Institutional Round is only for Private Unaided/Minority colleges and for seats remaining vacant after MOPUP I round.
2. All those candidates selected and joined during 1st round, 2nd round and MOP-UP round(s) in Government/Corporation/Government Aided/Private Unaided/Minority Colleges and having admitted status on or before 22/07/2020 **are NOT ELIGIBLE** to participate in Institutional Level Round.
3. For institutional round eligible and interested candidates should approach to the Dean/Principal of the respective colleges within prescribed time and submit application in person. Such type of applications should not be submitted in the State CET Cell in person or email. The applications submitted in State CET Cell will not be considered valid for any institutional level admission process.
4. At the time of admission during institutional round a candidate should submit all the original documents along with requisite fees during prescribed time limit, no extra time will be given.
5. The list of eligible candidates for the institutional round will be published on the website on **23/07/2020 at 05.00 PM**.
